

## Agent Delivery of Ballots

During the seven days before an election, and up until 2:00 pm on Election Day, certain voters may request Agent Delivery to receive their ballots.

- A hospitalized or health care facility patient
- Individuals in residential programs for adults
- Residents of shelters for battered women
- Resident of an assisted living facility
- A voter who had difficulty getting to polls due to incapacitating health reasons or disability

The voter must authorize the agent in writing (Agent Delivery of Absentee Ballot Application) as well as complete an Absentee Ballot Application. The applications may be faxed to the voter and the voter may return the applications by fax. Once these forms have been completed, the designated agent may pick up the ballot for the voter. Ballots being returned under this provision must arrive back to the Auditor's or Clerk's office by 3:00 p.m. on Election Day.
