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1. **Minnesota Vaccines for Children Program (MnVFC)** provides low cost, federally funded immunizations for children from birth through 18 years of age who:
 - Are enrolled in a Minnesota Health Care Program
 - ▶ MN Medical Assistance (MA),
 - ▶ General Assistance Medical Care (GAMC),
 - ▶ MinnesotaCare (MnCare), or
 - ▶ a prepaid Medical Assistance Program (PMAP)
 - do not have health insurance
 - are American Indian or Alaskan Native
 - have health insurance that does not cover vaccines
 - have health insurance covering only selected vaccines (MnVFC-eligible for non-covered vaccines only)
 - have health insurance which caps vaccine coverage at a certain amount; once the amount is reached, these persons are MnVFC eligible
 - have health insurance with any unmet deductible; once the deductible has been paid, the person is no longer MnVFC eligible
2. **Children who have health insurance, which covers the cost of all vaccines, are not eligible for this program.**
3. Available vaccines for children are: DTaP, Td/Tdap, Polio, Hib, MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella (Chickenpox), Pediatric Pneumonia (Prevnar), Meningococcal (Menveo), Hepatitis A, HPV (Human Papilloma Virus), Rotavirus and seasonal Influenza when available. Cost is \$14 per dose for administration fee.
4. Adults 19 years of age or older who are uninsured, insurance does not pay for vaccination or an enrollee of a MN Health Care Program (MA, GAMC, MnCare, or PMAP) may be eligible to receive some of the vaccines for the \$14 per dose administration fee.
5. The following vaccines are available to adults who do not qualify for the above program: Adult Td - \$35, Adult Tdap - \$50, Hepatitis A - \$40, Hepatitis B - \$45, Hepatitis A & B combinations(Twinrix) - \$60, Pneumonia - \$60, Flu shot - \$25, FluMist - \$25.
6. Bring an up-to-date immunization record. Immunizations given will be recorded in the MN Immunization Information Connection (MIIC) – statewide registry. Children should still see their physician for well-child visits.
7. An Adult MUST accompany each recipient under 18 years of age.
8. NO ONE REFUSED FOR INABILITY TO PAY.
