## Summary

It is requested that the County Board adopt the attached resolution to establish and designate the north segment of the Southeast Collector from CSAH 25 to TH 19 as County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 24.

## Background

The location of CSAH 24 was revised in 2013 to accommodate the TH 52 Intersection project, and the southern portion of the Southeast Collector was designated and built as a CSAH route through the TH 52 project up to CSAH 25. This northern segment of 24 is a continuation of that new CSAH route from CSAH 25 up to TH 19.

Next summer's Construction Program includes the construction of this northern segment of the Southeast Collector from CSAH 25 to TH 19. This segment needs to be designated by the State as a CSAH route before CSAH construction funds can be used on the project.

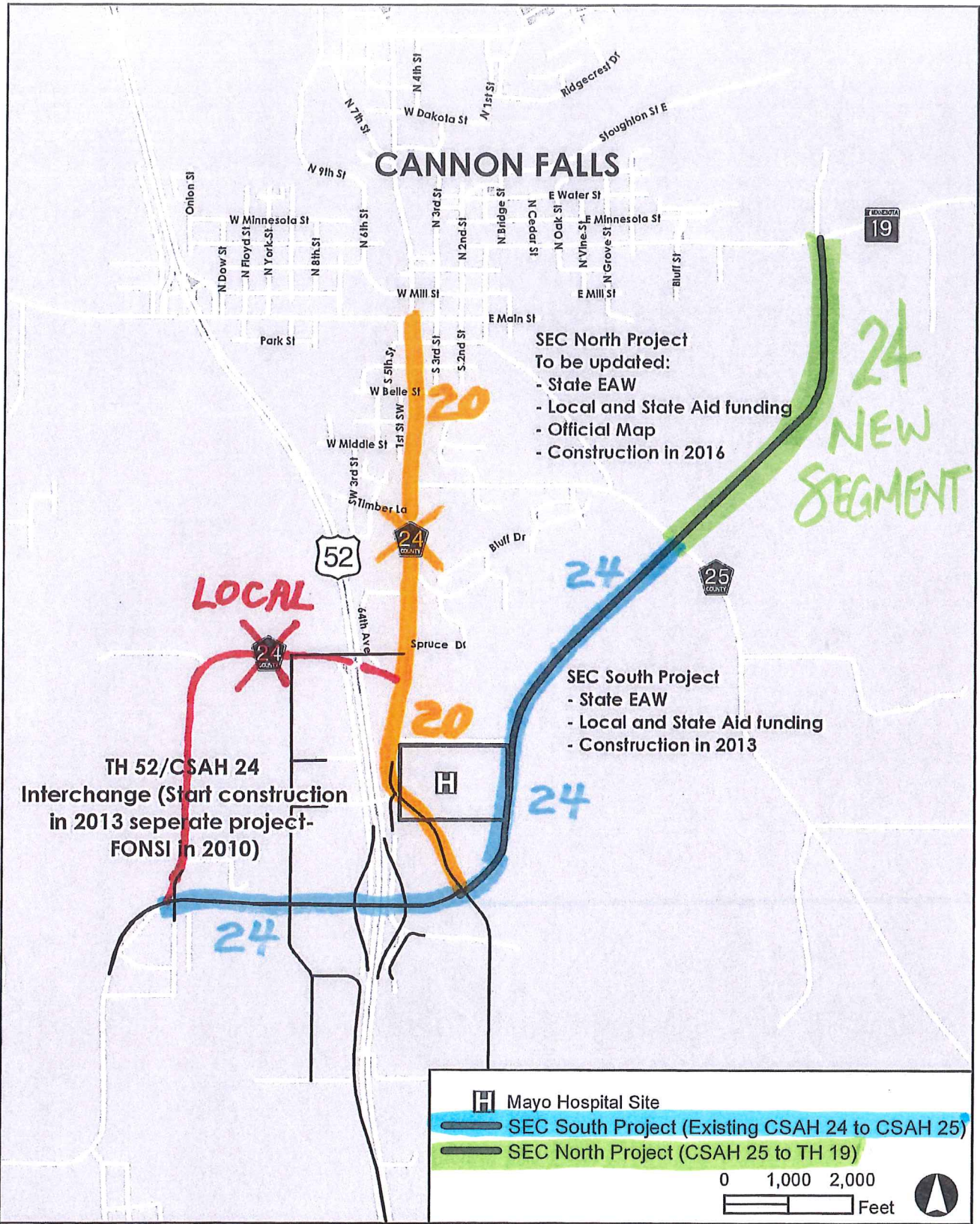
## Alternatives

- Adopt the attached resolution designating the new road (shown in green on the attached map) from CSAH 25 to TH 19 as CSAH 24.
- Do nothing. Under this scenario, CSAH funds could not be used for construction of this segment of the South East Collector.

**RESOLUTION  
ESTABLISHING COUNTY STATE AID HIGHWAY**

**WHEREAS**, It appears to the County Board of the County of Goodhue that the road hereinafter described should be designated County State Aid Highway under the provisions of Minnesota Laws:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of the County of Goodhue that the road described as follows, to-wit:

C.S.A.H. 24 Termini: From the junction of C.S.A.H. 25 northeast to the junction with T.H. 19. The new CSAH mileage is approximately 1.11 miles in length.

In T112N, R17W, beginning 0.2 miles south and 0.1 mile east of the NW Corner of Sec 20, then northeasterly through Sec 20 and Sec 17, to TH 19 at a point 0.5 miles east and 0.3 miles south of the NW Corner of Sec 17 and there terminating;

be, and hereby is established, located, and designated a County State Aid Highway of said County subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of Minnesota.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to forward two certified copies of this resolution to the Commissioner of Transportation for his consideration, and that upon his approval of the designation of said road or portion thereof, that same be constructed, improved and maintained as a County Sate Aid Highway of the County of Goodhue, to be numbered and known as County Sate Aid Highway 24.
