It is important to follow the necessary steps for successful implementation of a tobacco-free grounds policy.

Steps for passing a tobacco-free grounds policy

- Complete a tobacco use and policy opinion survey
- Complete a tobacco-free environmental assessment
- Convene a monthly committee
- Develop an action plan based on assessment findings that identifies short- and long-term goals
- Develop a draft policy statement and share with institution stakeholders
- Adopt and communicate the tobacco-free policy
- Offer tobacco cessation resources to employees and visitors
- Improve the grounds by removing cigarette receptacles and posting policy signage
- Monitor compliance with the tobacco-free grounds policy
